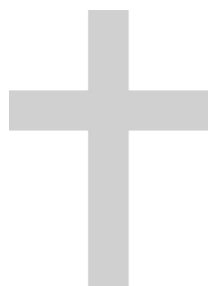

Tasks for KS1 classroom using these cards

1. Give out a pack of 7 quote cards to each table group of pupils
2. Ask them to read them (in turns) and can they reword the quotation together in their own language
3. Teacher brings pupils/class back together and asks if any group was stuck with a particular quote, and can another group help them understand it
4. Teacher can always translate any quotations pupils are stuck on
5. Then ask each pupil group to order the quotations to the one that is the most useful for their school, their country, the world! Is it the same or different – why? Bring groups back together and discuss what different groups have decided.
6. Give out religious and belief symbol cards. Ask pupils to identify what each symbol is for – show answers on PPT/board
7. Now ask pupils to guess which quotation goes with which symbol.
8. Teacher reveals answers, pupils see how many they got correct. In fact if they got none correct that is fine – the point of the task is for them to see that different religions and beliefs all say very similar things about how should people treat others.
9. Complete the activity with what wise word do they like the best. You might like pupils to write this quotation down and explain why they think this is important to create a good community.
